History of Ranking in CIC: 1998-99 to 2008-09

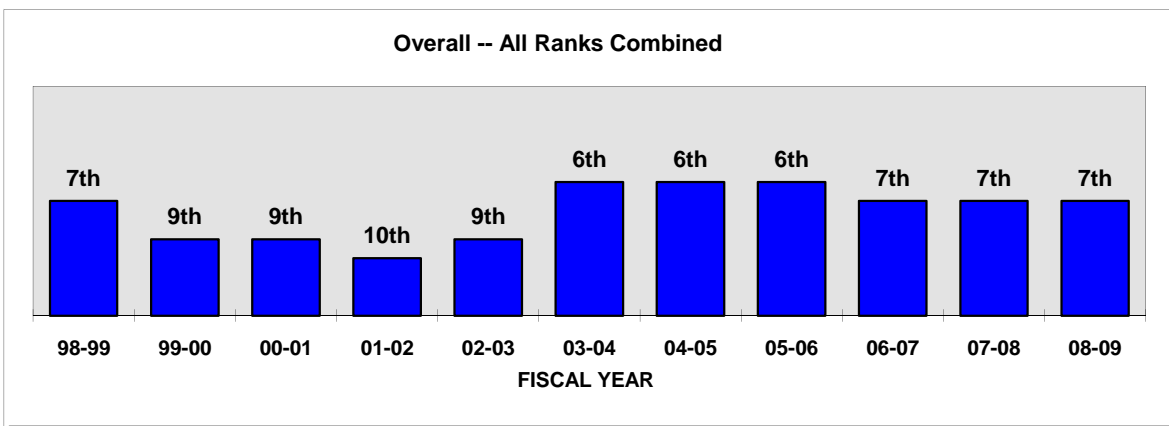
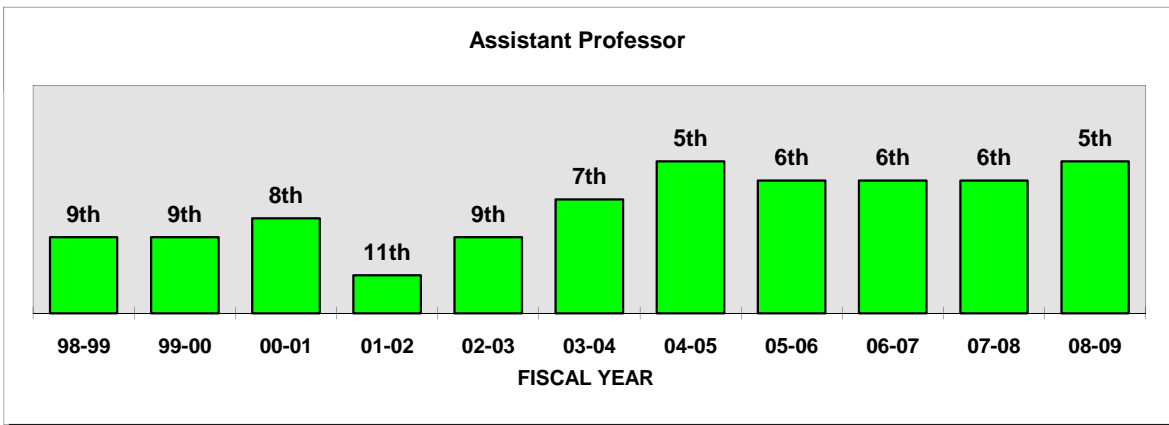
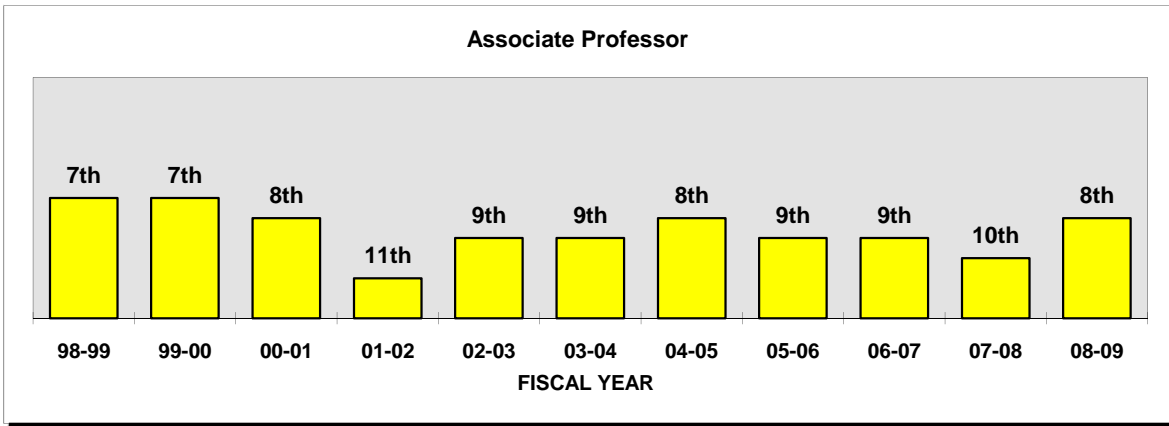
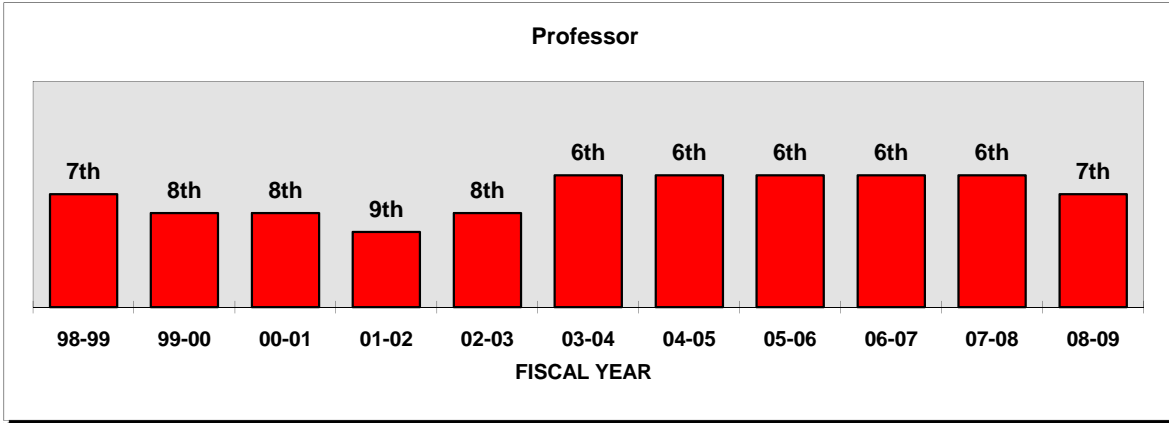

History of Ranking in CIC: 1982-83 to 2008-09

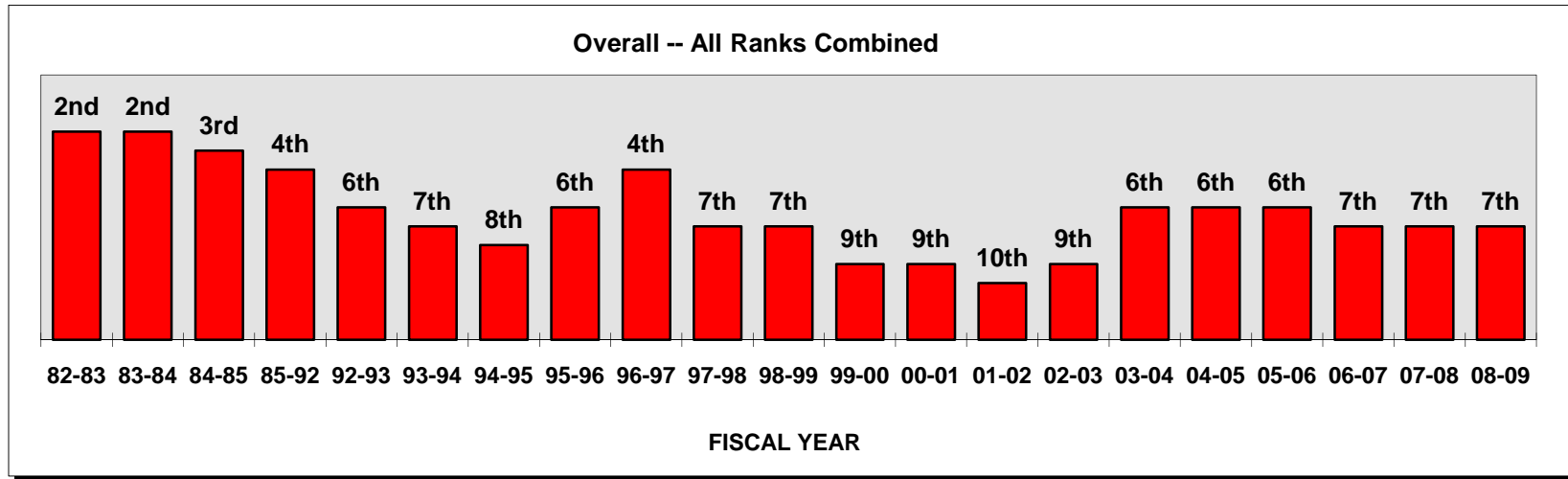

History of Ranking in Benchmark Institutions: 1998-99 to 2008-09

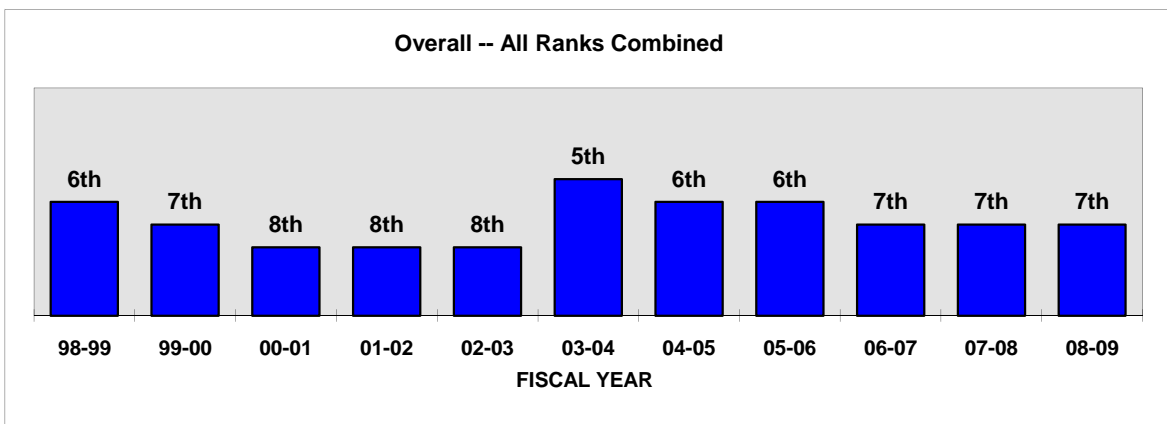
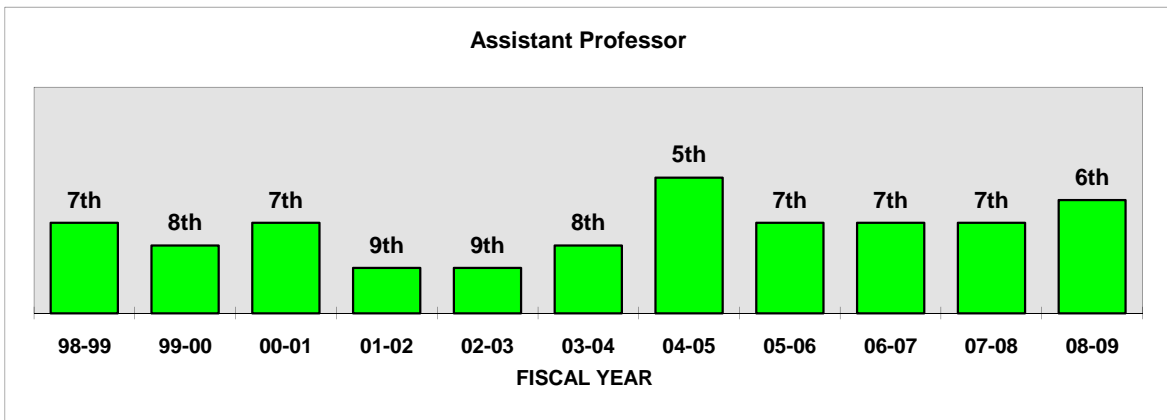
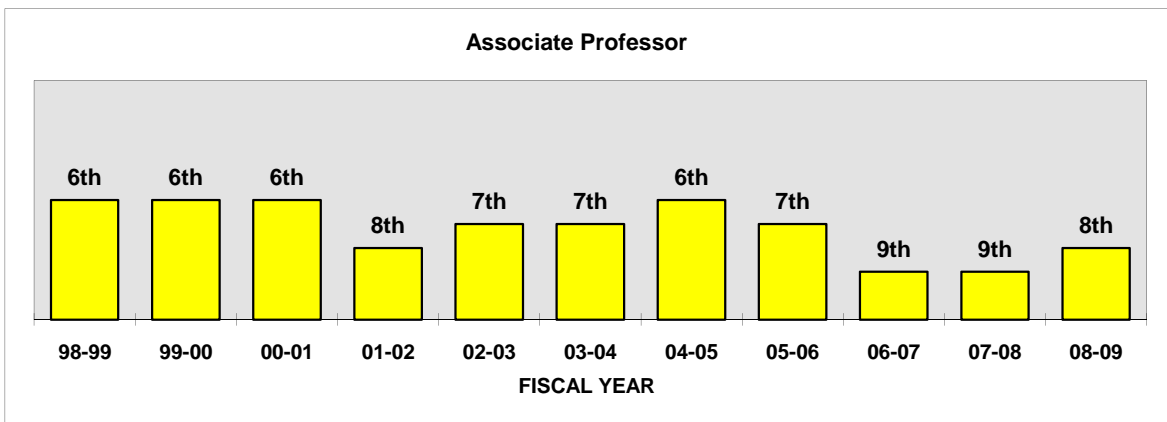
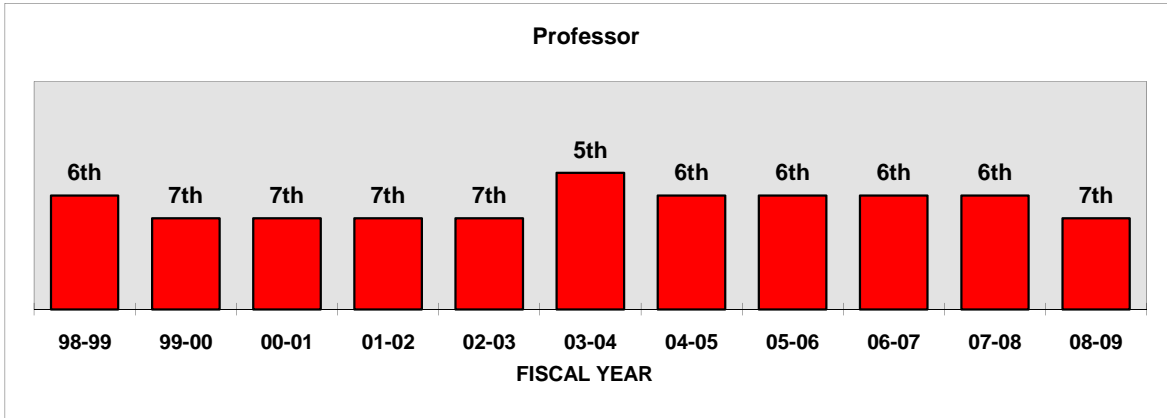
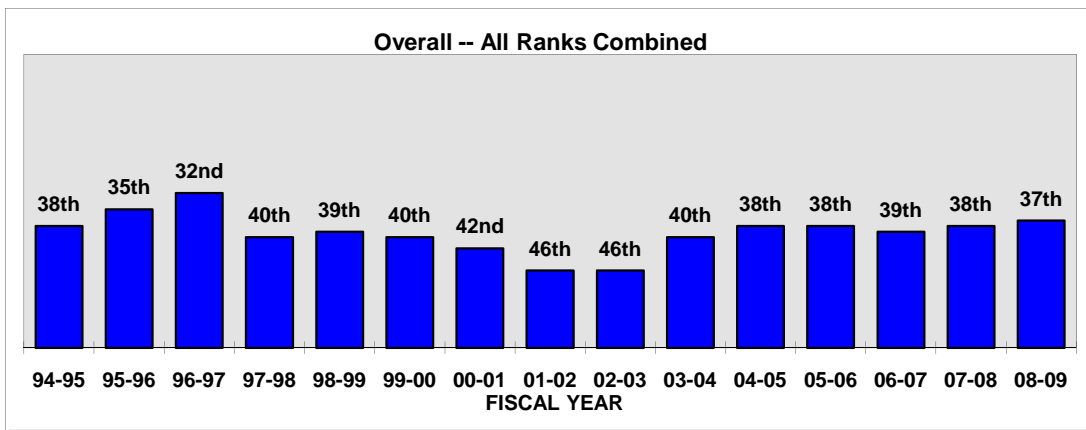
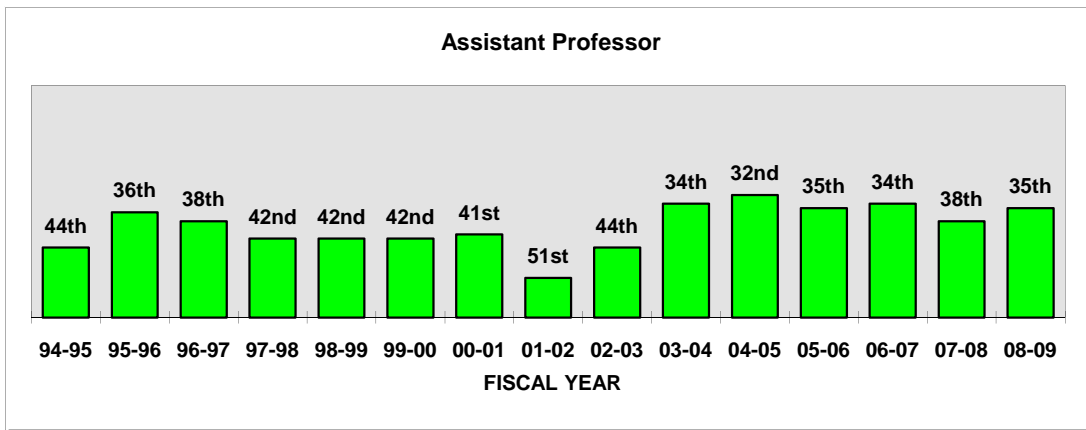
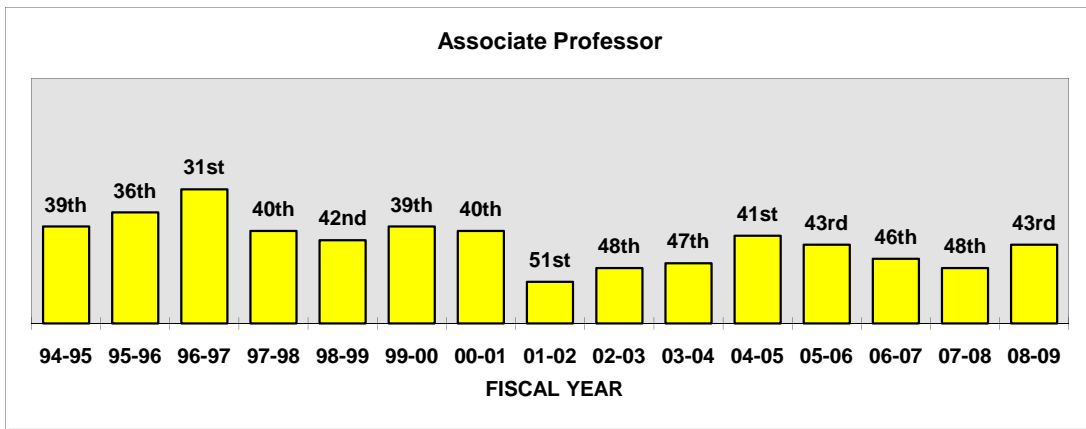
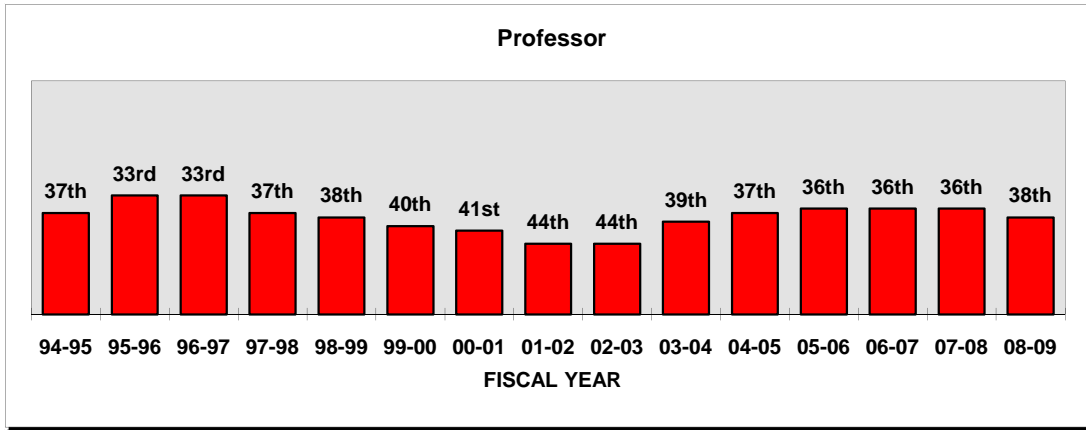

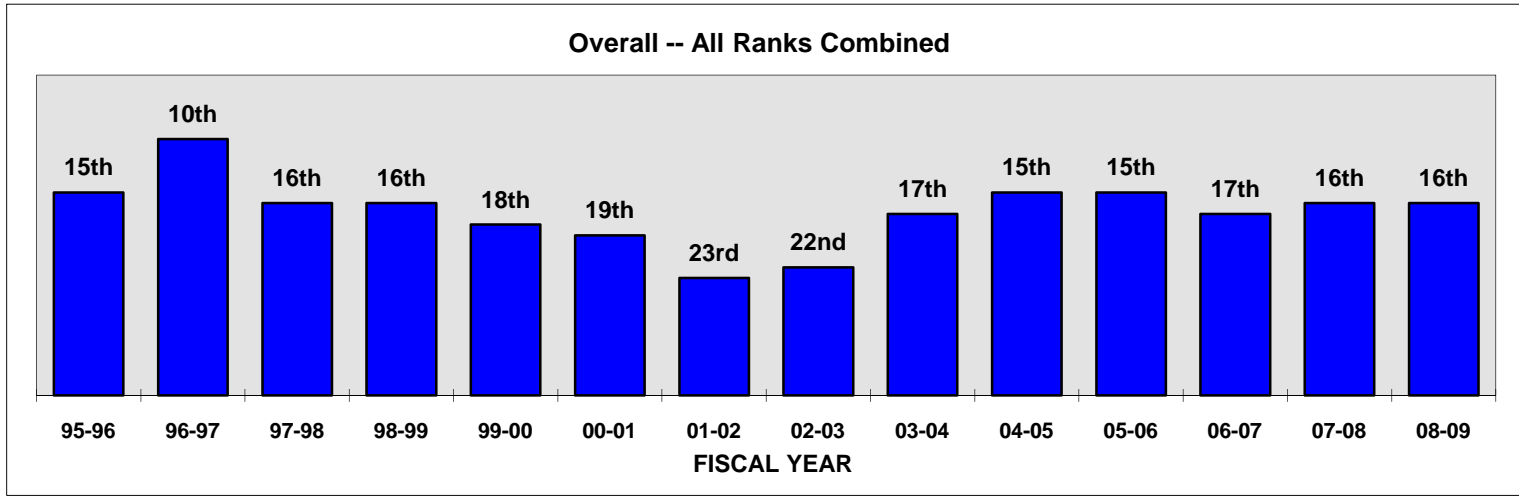
