# Quality/Service


#### Areas of Satisfaction

- Facility maintenance and cleanliness, upgraded lighting, and permit sales process ranked well
- Call response time and hold times improved
- In-person interaction with customer service staff has improved

# Quality/Service

#### Concerns

- Unmet expectations regarding:
- Parking privileges, availability and adequate supply in right location for a reasonable cost
- Displaced daily parkers for events
- CampusParc staff not viewed as friendly via phone/intercom
- Performance of garage equipment



# Quality/Service

#### Actions Taken to Address Concerns

- Investigated supply / demand options for WMC transit hubs and Lane Avenue Garages
- Procured \$5.5M in parking access and control equipment, installed 2017
- Invested ~ \$2M to seal 19 lots, restore 2 lots, repair 8 garages
- Upgraded lighting to 34 surface lots
- Refurbished elevators in 6 garages
- 64% of respondents provided 4 or 5 rating for improved cleanliness
- Hired new customer service manager
