

3335-13-08 and 3335-5-04.2 Research Misconduct

WHEREAS Faculty Rule 3335-13-08 sets forth the definition of research misconduct as defined by federal law, as well as the requirement that the university maintain a policy ensuring research integrity across the institution; AND

WHEREAS Faculty Rule 3335-5-04.2 outlines the process for investigating faculty accused of research misconduct and for sanctioning faculty found to have committed research misconduct; AND

WHEREAS these rules and policies are required by, and must be aligned with, federal law as overseen by the Office of Research Integrity on behalf of the Secretary of Health and Human Services; AND

WHEREAS recent title changes at the university and updates to timelines and terminology in federal policy necessitate revisions to Faculty Rules 3335-13-08 and 3335-5-04.2 to ensure alignment with federal law and current institutional practices; AND

WHEREAS the proposed changes were brought to Senate Rules Committee by the Office of Research Compliance; AND

WHEREAS the Rules Committee voted unanimously in support of this resolution at their meeting of December 5, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED that the University Senate approve the proposed revision to Faculty Rule 3335-13-08 and 3335-5-04.2 and respectfully requests the concurrence of the Board of Trustees, said proposal to be effective upon approval by the Board of Trustees.
