Whereas establishing this Center marks the culmination of a long collaboration between

the University's Institute for Materials Research and the Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, and is aligned with the University's Materials and

Manufacturing for Sustainability Discovery Theme; and

Whereas it meets the goal of creating meaningful connections with Indian institutions

where advanced clean technology, sustainable manufacturing, low energy

electronics and energy efficiency are directives; and

Whereas it will build on the complementary strengths of both institutions, similar

strategic goals, and existing faculty collaborations; and

Whereas the proposal adheres to the guidelines for the establishment of

centers/institutes, including clear mission, well defined administrative

organization, and resources; and

Whereas the proposal has the support of the Office of Research and the College of

Engineering; and

Whereas the proposal was reviewed by a subcommittee then reviewed and approved by

the Council on Academic Affairs at its meeting on October 21, 2020 and

presented for discussion with the Faculty Council; and
