| Whereas | the leadership of the Center for Higher Education Enterprise (CHEE) prepared a self-study focusing on, as required: mission; faculty and student involvement and contribution; administrative structure and responsibilities; budget; and evaluation criteria benchmarks; and   |
| Whereas | the review committee determined that a termination recommendation was<br>appropriate based on: a) substantive overlap/duplication of CHEE functions with<br>other existing centers/units on campus; b) cessation of funding and most<br>activities; and c) a lack of support from stakeholders to continue the status quo<br>operation of CHEE or to merge its functions with other centers/units on campus;<br>and |
| Whereas | the recommendation to terminate has the support of the Interim Director, and the Office of Academic Affairs to which it reports; and  |
| Whereas | the proposal from the Centers Review Committee to terminate CHEE was<br>thoroughly reviewed by the Council on Academic Affairs and approved at its<br>meeting on July 12, 2018;   |
