Revisions to Chapter 3335-19: Bylaws of the University Senate

- **Synopsis:** Revise the bylaws of the University Senate to clarify that Senate meetings may be held inperson, virtually, or in hybrid format, and that efforts be made to not hold senate meetings on days of major religious observance.
- **WHEREAS** the Rules Committee is charged with regularly reviewing the University Senate bylaws;
- WHEREAS the global pandemic has made clear the need for remote meeting capabilities;
- **WHEREAS** the bylaws of the university senate are currently silent on the conditions under which senate meetings may be held;
- **WHEREAS** the principal of majority voting should be maintained but the procedures for voting should remain flexible;
- **WHEREAS** the university senate should make a good-faith effort to schedule meetings to avoid conflicts with major religious observances;
- WHEREAS the Rules Committee unanimously approved this resolution and proposed language on November 12th, 2021;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a revision to chapter 3335-19 be approved by the University Senate and respectfully request concurrence of the Board of Trustees effective upon approval by the Board of Trustees.
