3335-3, 3335-5, and 3335-17 Remove Executive Dean title from the Rules

- Synopsis: Removes title of Executive Dean from the rules. Clarifies governance functions of former executive deans
- WHEREAS the university is working to reduce administrative hierarchy; and
- WHEREAS having flexibility in assembling leadership teams will allow for specific needs to be best addressed at any given time; and
- **WHEREAS** the removal of executive dean titles from the rules requires clarifying governance responsibilities on various senate committees; and
- **WHEREAS** it is important to recognize the substantially different needs of regional campuses, and a central role that the College of Arts and Sciences plays at the university; and
- **WHEREAS** the council of deans provides representation from all colleges, it is wellsituated to advise on governance appointments; and
- WHEREAS the Office of Academic Affairs supports this resolution;
- **WHEREAS** the Rules Committee approved this resolution and proposed language in February, 2022;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a revision to rule 3335-3, 3335-5, and 3335-17 and the bylaws of the University Senate be approved by the University Senate and respectfully request concurrence of the Board of Trustees effective upon approval by the Board of Trustees.
