## Hearings

During the 2023-2024 academic year, the Faculty Hearing Committee received two cases for adjudication. The first, initiated on April 21, 2024, involved a faculty member in the College of Medicine who faces dismissal from the university for failing to fulfill faculty obligations and academic responsibilities, as defined under Faculty Rule 3335-5-04.1. Professors Garcia (Presiding Officer), Garvin, Farmer, and Wellman (Alternate) volunteered to be part of a Hearing Panel. With my help, they have collected relevant documents and called witnesses to the hearing. At the time of writing, we have been unable to find a time to hold the hearing.

The second case, initiated on April 23, 2024, involves another faculty member from the College of Medicine who faces dismissal from the university for Research Misconduct, as defined under Faculty Rule 3335-5-04.2(E). Professors Janini (Presiding Officer), Lucente, Qin, and Pickler (Alternate) volunteered to be part of a Hearing Panel. With my help, they have collected relevant documents and called witnesses to the hearing. At the time of writing, we have been unable to find a time to hold the hearing.

## Meetings and Committee Engagement in Shared Governance

The full body of the Faculty Hearing Committee met once via Zoom during the 2023-2024 academic year on September 23. First Committee members introduced themselves, before the Chair and continuing members outlined the responsibilities of the committee.
