A PROPOSAL FROM THE COUNCIL ON ACADEMIC AFFAIRS TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE INSTITUTE FOR MATERIALS RRESEARCH TO THE INSTITUTE FOR MATERIALS AND MANUFACTURING RESEARCH

Whereas Since its establishment in 2006, the Institute for Materials Research (IMR) has

guided Ohio State's materials-allied research enterprise to be among the very best in the nation, winning the most prestigious and competitive awards, attracting top talent, and today is characterized by a large interdisciplinary community consisting of more than 268 faculty members from 34 departments

and 10 colleges; and

Whereas through the Discovery Themes program, the Materials and Manufacturing

Sustainability (M&MS) initiative helped IMR shift paradigm to focus on targeting global challenges and has led to IMR's Innovation Lab and the IIT Bombay-Ohio

State Frontier Center; and

Whereas based on the success of M&MS and work with key manufacturing centers such

as the Center for Design and Manufacturing Excellence the Ohio Manufacturing

Institute, the scope of IMR's work has expanded to converge with

manufacturing, now enhanced with ongoing interactions with Intel, Honda and

other strategic partners; and

Whereas in 2020, IMR leaders formed a manufacturing task force to create a visionary

plan to coordinate the manufacturing-related research, development and educational activities across the University to help it become a national leader in advanced manufacturing that has led to the new NSF-funded Engineering Research Center in advanced manufacturing; and the membership of the External Advisory Board has been changed to reflect a stronger manufacturing

component; and

Whereas the proposal has the support of the External Advisory Board, the Vice President

of Research, and the Fisher College of Business; and

Whereas the proposal was reviewed and approved by the Council on Academic Affairs at

its meeting on October 5, 2022; and

Therefore be it resolved that the University Senate approve the proposal to change the name of the Institute for Materials Research to the Institute for Materials and Manufacturing Research.
