The University Senate met in regular session on Thursday, October 22, 2020 at 3:30 PM remotely via CarmenZoom, with President Kristina Johnson presiding.  - discussion about when to provide breaks in instruction during spring semester 2021.

 - Proposal to change the name of the Department of Ophthalmology and Visual Science
 - Proposal to change the name of the Department of Theatre
- 4. Heard information about a newly created Graduate Ombuds position.
