### REPORT OF ACTIONS TAKEN AT THE MEETING OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE

The University Senate met in regular session on Thursday, October 27, 2022, at 3:30 PM on CarmenZoom, with President Kristina Johnson and Provost Melissa Gilliam presiding. There were 111 voting senators in attendance (78.7%). This report, along with the agenda, materials and verbatim recording constitute the minutes for this meeting.
