REPORT OF ACTIONS TAKEN AT THE MEETING OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE

The University Senate met in regular session on Thursday, April 17, 2025 at 3:30 PM in the Jean & Charles Schulz Lecture Hall in Sullivant Hall, with President Ted Carter presiding. There were 110 voting senators in attendance (78%), either in person or remotely. This report, along with the agenda, materials, and verbatim recording constitute the minutes for this meeting.

The Senate:

- 1. Approved Secretary's Report #418.
- 2. Heard President Carter's opening comments about the state of the university and thanking the senate for its work during a challenging year.
- 3. Approved proposals from the Council for Academic Affairs on the creation of Professional Master of Systems Engineering degree program and the establishment of The Ohio State Center for Software Innovation.
- 4. Approved Rules Changes to membership for the Committee on Academic Technology and Faculty Compensation and Benefits Committee.
- 5. Approved a resolution from Undergraduate Student Government in support of continued work on the Scarlet Button project.
- 6. Heard an update from Susan Cole, on the work of the committee charged with recommending and piloting updates to the university's instrument for student evaluation of instruction.
- Heard a presentation from Student Legal Services regarding the work of their office on behalf of students, including international students impacted by the current visa revocations by the federal government.
- 8. Heard end of year reports from senate constituent leaders Bobby McAlpine (President, Undergraduate Student Government), Sabrina Durso (President, Council of Graduate Students), Tyson Montgomery (President, Inter-Professional Council), Tracey Boggs (Chair, University Staff Advisory Committee), and Sara Watson (Chair, Faculty Council).
