Whereas the proposal has the support of the College leadership and faculty; and

Whereas the proposal was reviewed and approved by a subcommittee and then by the

full Council on Academic Affairs at its meeting on March 23, 2022; and

Therefore be it resolved that the University Senate approve the proposal to establish Clinical Track Faculty in the College of Social Work and respectfully requests approval by the Board of Trustees.
