A PROPOSAL FROM THE COUNCIL ON ACADEMIC AFFAIRS TO ESTABLISH AN EXECUTIVE MASTER OF HEALTH ADMINISTRATION, COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Whereas the Executive Master of Health Administration is an extension of the accredited

Master of Health Administration program (full-time, residential, early career) by

extending the reach of the program to a more experienced mid-career

professional; and peer institutions have such programs; and

Whereas the program is 45 credits, over 5 semesters (including Summer), is mostly online

and is cohort-based with 20-25 students per cohort expected; and

Whereas a curriculum was provided along with expected learning outcomes; all classes

are required with two new courses developed and approved for this program;

and

Whereas the proposal is supported by the Division of Health Services Management and

Policy and the College of Public Health; and

Whereas the proposal was reviewed by the combined Council on Academic

Affairs/Graduate School subcommittee and then the full Council at its meeting

on May 28, 2025,:

Now therefore be it resolved that the University Senate approve the proposal to establish an Executive Master of Health Administration program in the College of Public Health and respectfully request approval by the Board of Trustees.
