Issue addressed	The increase in faculty on campus that are in non-tenure track positions that are vital to the progress of students but have no representation on the committee.	
Proposal	<p>The committee proposes to increase the number of CESP members as follows (suggested new language in rule 3335-5-48.6 highlighted in red):</p> <p>(A) Membership.</p> <p>The council on enrollment and student progress shall consist of eighteighteen members.</p> <p>(1) Nine regular tenure-track faculty.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(a) Three regular tenure-track faculty appointed by the president. Appointed members are eligible for reappointment.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) Six regular tenure-track faculty selected by the Executive Committee of Faculty Council.</p> <p>(2) One non-tenure-track faculty member selected by the Executive Committee of Faculty Council.</p> <p>(3) Six students.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(a) Two graduate students.</p>	

	<p>(b) Two professional students.</p> <p>(c) Two undergraduate students.</p> <p>(4) Two <u>One</u> administrators. <u>Non-voting, appointed by the executive vice president and provost, or designee, non-voting, to serve as administrative liaisons for the council. One administrator shall represent the Office of Academic Affairs and one shall represent Enrollment Services.</u></p>
