

Proposal to Rescind University Faculty Rule 3335-13-02

WHEREAS the Ohio State University has adopted a tobacco free policy that supports a healthy environment for all members of the campus community; and

WHEREAS the use of all types of tobacco products is prohibited in all university buildings and on all university-owned properties, including parking lots, garages, and all outside areas; and

WHEREAS the full policy spells out all provisions of this campus tobacco ban at this website <https://hr.osu.edu/public/documents/policy/policy720.pdf>;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the University Senate Rescind Rule 3335-13-02 in its entirety.

~~The prohibition of the smoking of tobacco within university facilities designated as "No Smoking" areas by the authority delegated by the director of administrative services of the state of Ohio has been established to protect the comfort and health of persons who do not smoke or to whom such smoke is objectionable. Further, the smoking of tobacco in such designated areas is a violation of section 3791.031 of the Revised Code, and all violators are subject to prosecution.~~
