REPORT OF ACTIONS TAKEN AT THE MEETING OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE

The University Senate met in regular session on Thursday, March 8, 2018 at 3:30 PM in Saxbe Auditorium of Drinko Hall, with President Michael Drake presiding. There were 92 voting senators in attendance (68%). The meeting agenda and materials are located on the [senate website](#). This report, along with the agenda, materials and verbatim recording constitute the minutes for this meeting.

The Senate:

1. Approved Secretary's Report # 364.
2. Approved a new Intellectual Property Policy. The senate passed unanimously, with no discussion, an IP policy that took nearly four years of vigorous discussion, meticulous revisions, and thorough vetting.
3. Approved a proposal to award an honorary degree
 - Doctorate of Humane Letters honoris causa to Matthieu Ricard
4. Approved a resolution to require sexual misconduct training. This resolution was sponsored by the elected/appointed representatives of each of the constituencies that make up the university – faculty, staff, students and administrators.
