The University Senate met in regular session on Thursday, November 29, 2019 at 3:30 PM in Saxbe Auditorium of Drinko Hall, with President Drake presiding. There were 100 voting senators in attendance (74 %). This report, along with the agenda, materials and verbatim recording constitute the minutes for this meeting.

The Senate:
