REPORT OF ACTIONS TAKEN AT THE MEETING OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE

The University Senate met in regular session on Thursday, September 19, 2019 at 3:30 PM in the Film/Video Theatre of the Wexner Center for the Arts, with President Michael V. Drake presiding. The Senate:
