REPORT OF ACTIONS TAKEN AT THE MEETING OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE

The University Senate met in regular session on Thursday, March 25, 2021 at 3:30 PM remotely via CarmenZoom, with President Kristina Johnson presiding. There were 105 voting senators in attendance (74%). This report, along with the agenda, materials and verbatim recording constitute the minutes for this meeting.

The Senate:

- 1) Approved Secretary's Report #389.
- 2) Approved two resolutions from the Diversity Committee.
 - a) Resolution to remove the Bricker name from the University Administration Building.
 - b) Resolution to Review Names in Support of Diversity and Inclusion Core Values.
- 3) Approved two proposals from the Council on Academic Affairs.
 - a) Proposal to establish a Master of Science in Immunology and Microbial Pathogenesis.
 - b) Proposal to change the name of the Center for Slavic and East European Studies.

After the meeting was adjourned, the Executive Vice President and Provost Bruce McPherson provided the annual State of Academic Affairs Address.
